• Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance: Bob Nack, President

- Secretary's Report: was emailed in the spring and is online at <u>robertslake.com</u>

- Treasurer's Report: Rick Dietzler, Treasurer
 - Fisheree Report spreadsheet passed out by Mary Nack
 - o Best profit for Fisheree.
 - Bob Nack change of tap beer to can beer was advised by our distributor.
 - Beer sales went up in profit by \$987 by switching to cans.
- Old Business: Bob Nack
 - Loon Report: Carol Gezella read report written by Jim Borshe
 - 3 nest platform locations/2 locations where loons nested and hatched this year.
 - o Adults will be separated soon and leave for Gulf of Mexico.

• EWM and Fish Rehabilitation:

- Brett advised details of grant planning process given at Spring meeting
 - Minutes are on FB page and on RL website
 - o **Grants** 2 will be applied for
 - 1. To obtain funding for a Lake Management Plan
 - **2.** To obtain funding for EWM extraction

• EWM Grant process status:

- Onterra created proposal to create Lake Management Plan
 - <u>Lake Management Plan</u> = necessary to get State grant funding for
 EWM removal
 - Proposal = was accepted on behalf of RLA
 - Pre-Application to DNR \rightarrow due on September 15, 2023
 - Brett working w/ Onterra and will be timely submitted.
 - Final Grant Application to DNR \rightarrow due on November 15, 2023
 - Brett and Onterra will work together to timely file.
- <u>Herbicide Application</u> = cost is roughly \$40,000 per application
- Water clarity testing
 - Brett Kaehne and Gus Nordholm were trained by Sandy Wickman of DNR for water clarity testing on Memorial Weekend
 - Previously done by Don Schroeder
 - Water clarity testing = will assist in obtaining grant funding
 - DNR looks favorably to Lake Assc. That are looking out for lake and proactive

- Brett Kaehne demonstrates how testing works w/ secci disc
 - Monthly testing = good
 - Every 7-10 days = better
 - Brett and Gus not living on lake full-time.
 - Brett asks for a volunteer to take over testing.

Zebra Mussels Testing

- o Brett Kaehne and Gus Nordholm trained Memorial Weekend.
- Brett explains how testing works (plastic plates on screw, placed just above lake bottom, tied to pier).
- September → Brett and Gus to remove devices and submit written testing results to DNR.
- o Brett advised he will continue handling this testing.

• Fish Rehabilitation Project:

- o Bob Nack reads email to Gus from Greg Matzke from DNR
 - RL on odd year for stocking, plan to stock 15 per acre of large fingerling walleye 6,000+ fish.
 - People are catching walleye growth rates of walleye will be better as perch rates have taken off.
 - 4 year old males = 14 inches, 4 year old females = 16 inches.
- o Reviewed size/species of fish caught at RLA Fisheree.
- o DNR stocking fish this year (odd year), RLA stocks on even years.

New Business:

- <u>DNR on lake recently</u> been checking crab traps, sometimes at night.
 - Fyke nets testing
- Pontoon Boat: Bob Nack
 - o "Duke", Lee Lamers neighbor donated boat to RLA in past.
 - Have tossed around ideas of using boat for DASH or selling.
 - Lee Lamers found a buyer, Al Pechotta, (business in Wabeno)
 - Purchased RLA pontoon for \$3,000.
