

- EWM/Lake Management- reported Survey done in fall. Cost \$3,000. Cost for picking around \$4,000. DNR did fund us \$4,400. Our fisherie made \$20,000, last year. Lake management Plan was voted down last year. Report will be mailed out. Discussion if we should continue this. Should we do report and picking. Voted no on Lake Management plan. Option to do nothing for one year-8 votes. 42 voted to continue program. 5 voted not to pick and do survey. Conclusion to continue program.
