I also understand that some of the readings will be of a more mature and sensitive nature. These readings are assigned by the University of Cambridge and are non-negotiable. Students and parents must also understand the importance of computer access for Cambridge AICE students. Students should have access to a computer with internet and printing capabilities. Finally, all students should maintain a minimum of a C average in all courses, a 2.50 unweighted core GPA overall and adhere to the BHS Cambridge AICE attendance policy. I understand the consequences for not meeting these standards may result in dismissal from the BHS Cambridge AICE program or individual AICE courses. If Booker High School is not my districted school and I am removed from the BHS Cambridge AICE program, I may be returned to my districted high school. Cambridge AICE exams may take place outside of the school year (as late as the second week in June), and students are expected to take these exams.</p>
