Procedures & Rules

- Key times: 9:00 and 1:00
- Do not bring any materials into the testing room
 - Leave backpacks in the fishbowls or in another safe location
 - Absolutely <u>NO</u> cell phones in testing rooms
 - All testing materials will be provided to you
- No talking or any other form of communication from the time you enter the testing room until the time you exit the testing room
 - Quiet testing environment at all times
- If testing rules are broken, Cambridge decides if your test is scored or not
 - **Follow all rules.** Don't give anyone a reason to invalidate your test

Procedures & Rules (con't)

> Water

You can bring water into the testing room ONLY if it's in a clear, plastic bottle with no label on it.

> Restrooms

- > Only 1 student may use the restroom at a time
- Fests that are 1 hour & 30 minutes and less will not be allowed rest room breaks.
- If you use the restroom, you do not get back the time on the test that you missed.
