I have been a Voice Teacher for over 40 years and have taught hundreds of students in those years. Although I have degrees in both Vocal Performance in Opera and Music Education, my music genre passion is the Broadway Musical Theatre. I teach primarily the Broadway and contemporary Christian styles of singing. I am a believer in teaching students how to sing properly – using diaphragmatic support, breath control, forward focus and a natural singing style.



It is important for students to understand that learning (and using) proper vocal technique is a TRAINING process, and it certainly cannot happen in "a few easy lessons". It is the same as with any performing art or sport: It takes dedication, sacrifice and time to become an excellent singer. Every student I teach begins their journey at their own particular level of learning, talent and potential. Each student is unique in his/her learning styles and talent.

Many students have a desire to pursue roles in the Musical Theatre genre. Like any of the disciplines in the performance arena, singing correctly does not come naturally to most singers. An understanding of the necessity of establishing a healthy vocal singing technique is vitally important. Private vocal coaching will, at the very least, reveal to each student his or her vocal strengths and weaknesses. Then they will be able to set short-term and long-term goals to begin to establish their vocal technique.

The vocal progress made by the student can be doubled or tripled by how much concentrated practice time and effort is maintained. (*Please read that sentence again!*) It is the responsibility of the instructor (ME) to offer the tools needed to establish a healthy vocal technique. It is the student's responsibility to begin to use those tools effectively.

Please read the following FAQs re: Voice Lessons. These should answer most any question you might have, but feel free to ask more questions should you have them.

FAQs about Voice Lessons January 2025

Where is your Voice Studio?

I teach from my home studio in Virginia Beach: 1013 Sunnyside Drive.

What will we do during our voice lessons?

We will work toward your individual goals of vocal production training (proper breath control and diaphragm support, forward vocal placement and focus, vowel modification, diction, stage presence, posture, and microphone technique). When applicable, we will prepare audition and performance pieces.

How often do I have a lesson?

I require that you take one lesson per week. If you desire to study voice and work towards establishing and maintaining a healthy vocal technique, you need consistent training and practice. 40+ Years of teaching have proven unequivocally to me that weekly study is necessary to promote motivated and disciplined study and progress.

How long of a commitment is required?

I require that you make a **Semester commitment** to study voice with me and **four weeks' notice** when you plan to cease lessons for any reason. Fall Semester begins in mid-August/September, & Winter/Spring Semester begins in January.

Should I take a half hour lesson or an hour lesson?

A half hour lesson enables us to spend about 15 minutes on warm-ups and exercises, and another 15 minutes on a song. If you come to your lesson warmed-up and ready to sing, we will have more time for exercises and technique work. For serious and more advanced students who want more intense training and repertoire time, I recommend an hour lesson.

How much practice time is recommended?

I recommend working on warm-ups and exercises a minimum of 20-30 minutes five days a week for beginning students. (Advanced students shouldn't be asking this question!) Song repertoire work and memorization time depends on your schedule as well as your goals – but an additional half hour five days a week (in addition to your lesson time) would be a minimum! Remember: without hours of independent, self-motivated practice time, you will NEVER reach your goals.

Should I bring my own music to my lesson?

By all means!! I will certainly make recommendations of certain songbooks or sheet music you should purchase, and I will inform you where you can purchase them. (www.musicnotes.com OR www.sheetmusicdirect.com).

Why do you recommend recording my voice lesson?

Recording each lesson not only enables you to practice your warm-ups and exercises along with the piano (and in the correct key!), but you will also be able to hear progress that is made during the lesson. You will be reminded of those "little suggestions" that can make such a difference -- but are easy to forget when you're practicing at home.

I record your lesson on my computer and will email an mp3 to you (via Hightail, a large file-sending app).

What is the tuition fee for voice lessons?

- Weekly Half hour lesson.....\$45 x 4 weeks = \$180/month
- Weekly Hour Lesson......\$80 x 4 weeks = \$320/month

I will be sending a monthly reminder invoice via email by the first week of each month.

When is the tuition fee due?

Payment for the <u>entire month</u> is due the first lesson of the month, unless other written arrangements are made with me. (I do understand that for some family budgets, other arrangements are necessary, and that's no problem, as long as we discuss it.)

Tuition Payment can be CASH or CHECK written to Kathi-Lee Wilson.

**NOTE: Payments after the 15th of each month will incur a \$10 late fee, unless this has been prearranged with me. Please understand that as much as I enjoy teaching private students, this is a business. I depend upon this income just as YOU depend upon the fruits of your labor to meet your monthly budget requirements.

What if there are 5 weeks in a month?

This is Optional. If there are 5 Mondays, Tuesdays, etc. in a specific month, we can discuss plans. Most of the time we will skip the 5th week.

Is there a Registration fee?

Yes. There is a \$50 non-refundable Registration Fee (due by SEPT. 1 for the Fall Semester & January 10 for the Spring semester. This is not a deposit – it is a fee in addition to your monthly tuition. After you submit the registration form AND this fee is paid, you are assured of a place in my studio. We can then immediately schedule your regular lesson time.

What if my voice lesson time conflicts with rehearsals for a show in which I've been cast?

When you audition for a show, don't forget to list your voice lesson time as a potential schedule conflict. Directors who want the best performance out of our singers often have to make allowances for their training and education, even if it means that the performer has to miss a little show rehearsal time. As a Musical Director, I am grateful for the actors/singers who have private vocal instruction, for it not only helps the performer, but it also helps the show! Makeup lessons for final dress rehearsals and performances will be arranged if at all possible!

If I have to cancel a lesson, will I be able to make it up?

This depends on the circumstances. I attempt to be flexible when it comes to make-up lessons, for I understand that emergencies and the common cold do not necessarily adhere to our schedules! However, the pre-arranged lesson time is reserved for you, and if you cancel, I cannot always guarantee a make-up lesson.

Here are a couple of specific policies:

- 1) If <u>YOU</u> cancel your lesson and we are unable to arrange a make-up lesson during the month, the fee is non-refundable.
- 2) If your lesson is canceled by <u>ME</u> and we're unable to schedule a make-up time, you will be credited that lesson the following month.

PLEASE NOTE CAREFULLY:

If you cancel the <u>same day</u> or <u>do not show up for a lesson</u> (or make-up lesson) for any reason, please know that I will be sitting at the piano in your honor, for you have paid for that time already. I cannot offer a make-up lesson.

If I am running late for my lesson I will send KL a text message if at all possible.
