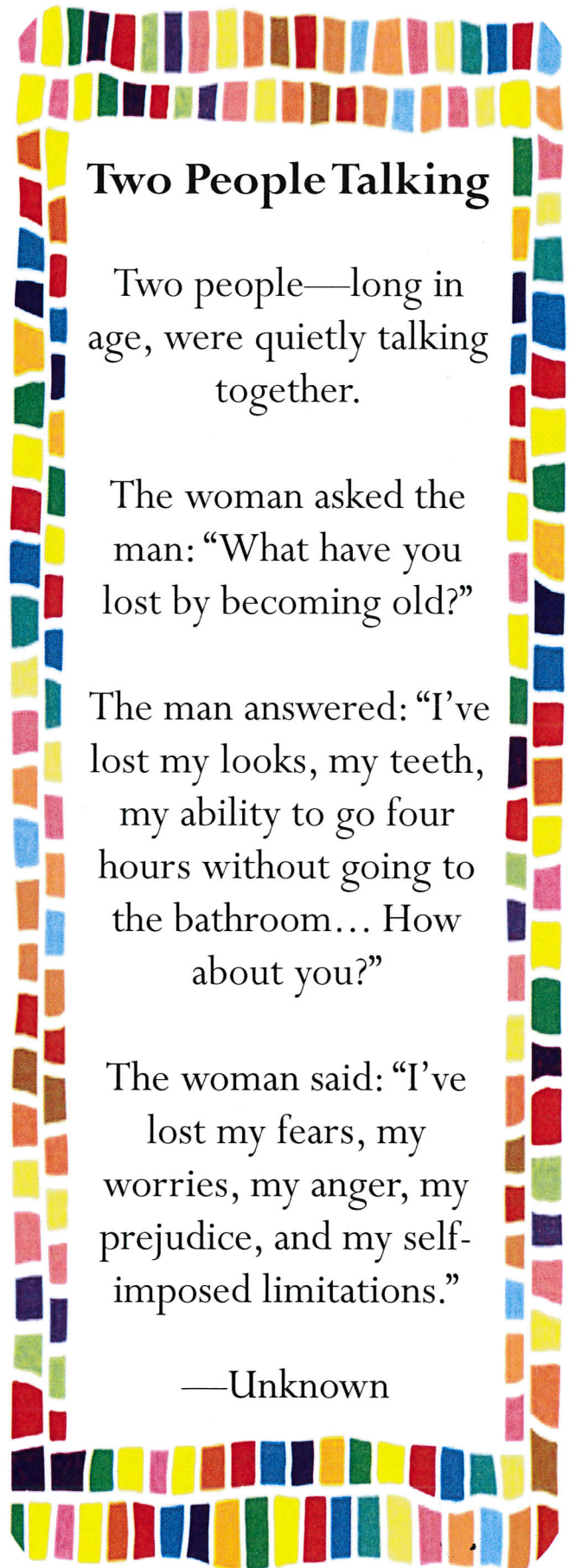

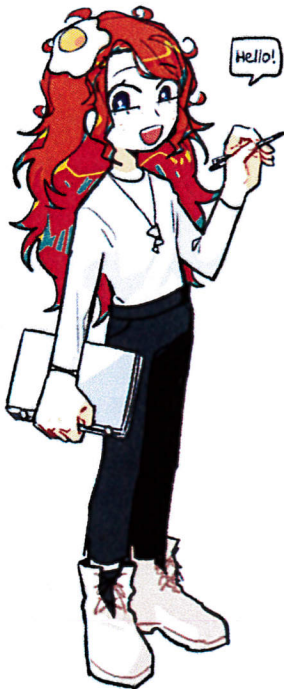

Did You Know...?

HOW TO GET YOUR MAIL AND OTHER DELIVERIES AT HOPE WOODS



mailboxes

Envelopes and anything else that can fit inside your mailbox will go here. USPS will deliver packages to your door.

packages

Anything delivered from UPS, FedEx, or any other package carrier is likely to be dropped off at the small, square table in the lobby entrance. This area is monitored by 24-hour surveillance. A Resident volunteer will deliver your package to your door if you have not already picked it up yourself.



Food / grocery orders

When ordering online through services like DoorDash, GrubHub, Shipt, etc., we suggest that you keep an eye on the tracking of your order and come down to the lobby to meet with your driver 5 minutes before they are due to arrive.

We are not always in the Office to guide visitors, and they often do not know how to navigate our building. Meeting your driver will ensure your food is not left in the lobby without your knowledge.
