- A maintenance emergency is something involving appliances, leaks, damage to the building structure, etc. A full list of emergencies can be found in your Resident Rules & Regulations packet.

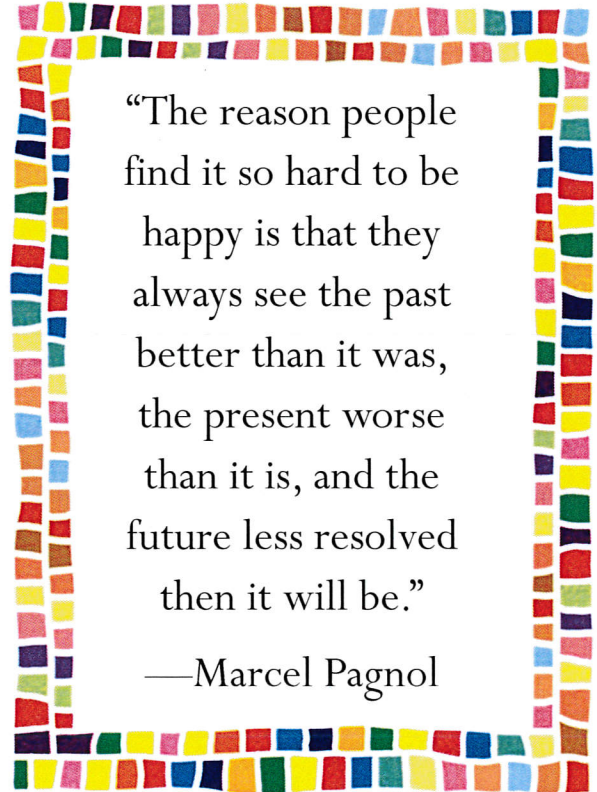
