

GIVING TUESDAY

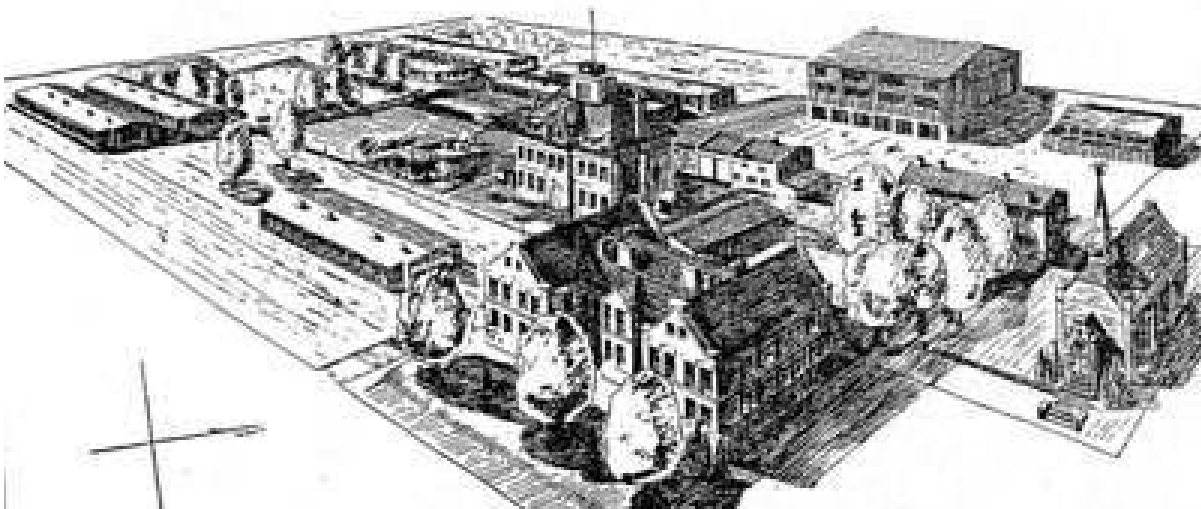
“GivingTuesday was created in 2012 as a simple idea: a day that encourages people to do good. Over the past nine years, this idea has grown into a global movement that inspires hundreds of millions of people to give, collaborate, and celebrate generosity.”

Friends of Oflag 64, a registered 501(c)(3), is participating in this year’s “Giving Tuesday”, November 30. We are the American component of a two-pronged institutional approach to building a museum in Szubin, Poland, dedicated to commemorating the experience of American POWs who were held in captivity at Oflag 64 during World War II. Our efforts are coordinated with project goals and objectives set by the Polish-American Foundation for the Commemoration of POW Camps in Szubin located in Poland, the membership of which is made up of Polish and American citizens. The Foundation is directly responsible for the logistical coordination and implementation of project activities (i.e. building logistics, communication coordination between Szubin government officials and project leaders, and exhibit design.)
