But many of us can admit that it is those very traumas and wounds that brought us closer to the Lord so we see His brilliance there too! It is in our healing where it becomes necessary to open up to Him and we are brought deeper unto Him! His Truths, His Love, His Life!

And when we take a look at the world, everything is not ok, nor are our brothers and sisters who do not know the Lord.

That is why when we go out in the world as vessels of Love with Jesus in us - not walking around in judgement, fear, pride or superiority of knowing better - His Truth, His Light, and His Love can reach/touch people's hearts and heal them!
