



# RIDE LEADER INFORMATION

Thank you so very much for volunteering to lead a ride for your Raleigh HOG chapter! It is members like you that step forward that make this chapter the best HOG chapter anywhere and the officers, board and all the membership really appreciate it!

The forms listed below in this email have information to help you get ready to lead your ride. Whether you're leading a ride for the first time or the hundred and first, our goal is to provide you whatever help you need in making your ride successful.

The forms below will help you get ready for ride day. (The underlined form titles are Hyperlinks)

A [Ride Leader Checklist](#) of things to consider in making your ride successful, including thoughts to consider in planning your ride, and briefing points to be used before heading out on ride day.

The [Rider Sign-in Form](#) is for riders to sign in on the day of the ride. Please print a copy and bring it with you on ride day (there are copies at the dealership in a bin in the outdoor restroom if you need them).

The [Road Captains List](#) is your resource for getting help in doing a pre-ride, getting advice on route planning, and lining up help for ride day.

A release form is required for anyone going on the ride who is **not** a current Raleigh HOG member. (**Note:** A release is required for all Minors – whether they are members or not!) You should have several of these with you on ride day. There are three waivers you may need:

- [Event release for Adults](#) - Signed by Adult, Non-members.
- [Event release for Minors](#) - Signed by Parent or Guardian of Minor (under 18, member or not).
- [Minor's Assumption of Risk](#) - Signed by Minor, if 12 years of age or older.

It is also a good idea to have an Injury Report form with you in the event an injury occurs:

- [Injury Report Form](#) - Fill out in the event of an injury. Also, call someone from the list below.

After the ride you should turn in the Rider Sign-in Form and the Release Forms to the lead road captain, the receptionist at the dealership, or one of the road captains on your ride who can forward them to the lead road captain.

If the ride includes visiting a restaurant you are encouraged to call the restaurant to give them an estimate of the number of riders before the ride leaves the dealership.

Please remember that we DO NOT cancel rides unless there are extreme circumstances! If there is severe weather that would create a hazardous condition or if there is a situation that arises that would prevent you from being able to lead the ride, please contact one of the following people immediately;
