Our eight-week summer program, available for incoming kindergarteners through incoming fifth graders, begins on **Monday, June 16 and ends on Friday, August 08**. Our program has a good balance of playtime and study time. We provide academic instruction every morning from 9 am until lunchtime (Mon-Thurs). From 1 pm-3 pm, we offer a variety of free activities, including dance, crafts, group projects, movies, game time, and sports camps. These experiences are not just fun; they also teach coordination, cooperation, and listening skills.

Fee Schedule

Tuition is charged weekly and due on Monday. When you register on Brightwheel, for each week selected, we will require a small non-refundable deposit of \$20 per student, which holds your spot, leaving you to pay the remaining balance for the weeks attended. If it is more convenient, you can pay for several weeks at a time. Program hours are 9 am-3 pm. Weekly tuition covers all hours between 6 am-6 pm.

There is no daily rate available.
