Our eight-week summer program, available for **incoming first through incoming fifth graders**, begins on **Monday, June 15, and ends on Friday, August 7**. Our program has a good balance of playtime and study time. We provide academic instruction every morning from 9 am until lunchtime (Mon-Thurs). From 1 pm-3 pm, we offer a variety of free activities, including dance, crafts, group projects, movies, game time, and sports camps. Bus trips or special on-campus events every Friday. These experiences are not just fun; they also teach coordination, cooperation, and listening skills.

Fee Schedule

Tuition is charged weekly and due on Mondays. \$20 late fees will be applied on Wednesdays. When you register on Brightwheel, for each week selected, we will require a small non-refundable deposit of \$20 per student, which holds your spot, leaving you to pay the remaining balance for the weeks attended. If it is more convenient, you can pay for several weeks at a time. Program hours are 9 am-3 pm. Weekly tuition covers all hours between 6 am-6 pm. There is no daily rate available.

Holding deposit: \$20 per selected week

Registration completed on or before June 1st

1 child: \$160 per week (\$140 + \$20 weekly holding deposit)

2 children: \$300 per week (\$260 + \$40 weekly holding deposit)



Registration fee: \$150

Registration completed after June 1st

1 child: \$170 per week (\$150 + \$20 weekly holding deposit)

2 children: \$320 per week (\$280 + \$40 weekly holding deposit)

Lunch & Snacks

Lunch and am/pm snacks are complimentary. A summer menu is available in the office. We serve complimentary fruit or vegetables every morning for nutrition break. Students may purchase a \$20 snack card from the office to buy additional snacks. Please bring a labeled refillable water bottle to school every day.

Note- You are also welcome to pack lunch for the day.

Summer Information

Please initial each section.

Academics: Monday through Thursday begins with three hours of academic study. Class starts at 9am and it is important to be on time. Our goal for the educational portion of the summer is to reinforce what the students have learned the previous year and help prepare them for the upcoming year.



Field Trips: Students enjoy bus trips, local walking trips, and special on-campus activities every Friday. We provide transportation, supervision, admission, and lunch for every off-campus adventure.



Summer Shirt: Included with the registration and required for all off-campus events. If your child is not wearing their summer shirt on a trip day you will be charged for and given an extra shirt. Extra shirts are \$13 each.



McDonalds' Monday: You have two lunch options every Monday. You can eat the complimentary lunch or purchase lunch from McDonald's. Order forms are available in the office. The price is \$5-\$7.50 per lunch, and they will be delivered directly to the school. Pay online or in the office. Exact change preferred.



Water Play Thursdays: Students should arrive wearing swimwear under their clothes, with sunscreen already applied. Please bring a labeled bag that contains flip-flops or water shoes, a change of underwear, a towel, and a plastic bag for wet clothes.



Shoes: For safety and insurance requirements, students must wear well-fitting, closed-toe shoes that are slip-on or have a velcro closure (clogs and Crocs are not allowed). Water shoes are permitted during Thursday water play activities.
