- Tuition will not be posted until July 1st. If you enroll your dancer prior to July 1st, it will say "\$0.00" due. Tuition can be paid with a card in the parent portal or with cash or check during studio hours.
- IF A DANCER NEEDS TO DROP A CLASS I MUST BE NOTIFIED BY JUNE 30TH. OTHERWISE YOUR DANCERS SPOT IS SECURED AND FULL TUITION IS DUE.
- Tuition is due in full. No discounts or refunds will be given for classes not taken.

- Covid 19
 - a. Masks are optional.
 - b. If the studio is notified that a student tested positive their class will be notified ONLY if that dancer was in class 48 hours prior to testing positive.
 - c. The studio follows the CDC guidelines and recommendations. Please visit the CDC website for more information on what to do if your dancer tests positive or has been exposed.
- Parent observation is only allowed in the FIRST class of the summer session (the week of July 11th) and the LAST week of the summer session (the week of August 15th). In the past we've run into some issues with parent observations such as: talking on cell phones, talking amongst each other, talking directly to their dancer during class and bringing multiple family members/siblings/friends to watch. This causes an incredible amount of distraction for the dancers, teacher and fellow parents trying to observe. In order to continue to provide professional learning environment, we ask that:
 - 1. One parent comes to watch (no siblings please).
 - 2. No talking on cell phones.
 - 3. No talking amongst each other.
 - 4. No talking to your dancer during their class.

If you are unable to follow these rules, we kindly ask that you don't observe class.

Dancers must be 3 years old at the start of the session. Our expectations for the little
ones are that they are fully potty trained, able to be in class without a parent present
and are able to follow instructions given by the teacher.
