

General Studio Policies

General:

Enrollment is based on an annual basis (September-June Recital). Because continued attendance is essential for maintaining class progression and is necessary for improving and maintaining each dancer's technique, "taking time off of classes" is not permitted without prior approval and in extenuating circumstances only.

In order to ensure the most professional and beneficial environment for learning dance, all students must wear their hair pulled back securely away from their faces and dress in proper attire as described in the studio dress code. Proper footwear must also be worn.

Dancers must be 7 years of age prior to enrolling in classes. (Exceptions may be made at the discretion of the studio director.)

Tuition:

COVID-19 REFUND POLICY

If another county or state shutdown is required while classes are in session, all classes will transition to Zoom. If a dancer does not wish to take Zoom classes, they can drop the class on the 1st of the month. No refunds will be given if a student contracts Covid-19 or is in a class with someone who tests positive for Covid-19. No refunds will be given if a student misses class because of traveling and having to self-quarantine. No refunds will be given for unattended classes or studio vacations.

Tuition can only be paid one month at a time. No advanced payments will be accepted.

Tuition is paid based on a yearly rate. Tuition is the same amount each and every month (September-June). There is an annual \$15 registration fee for each student.

Tuition is due the 1st lesson of each month and is considered delinquent after the 10th of the month. Please make your payments in a timely manner. If you need to make special arrangements for tuition payments, please contact the studio and we will work out the details. Any tuition that is paid after the 20th of the month will have a \$10.00 late fee added to it.

Only 1 person responsible for tuition please. If tuition will be coming from multiple sources there must be only 1 person listed as the contact. This is to avoid complications with payments.

Attendance:

If your dancer is going to miss 2 or more classes in a row please let your teacher know ahead of time or email the office. If you don't know ahead of time, please email the office as soon as you do know.

Dancers must arrive to class on time. If dancers miss the temperature screening window (5-10 minutes before class) they will not be permitted to enter.

Dancers enrolled in Zoom classes must also arrive at the Zoom waiting room on time. If a dancer is not in the waiting room on time, the teacher cannot let them into class.
