## Vision Mission

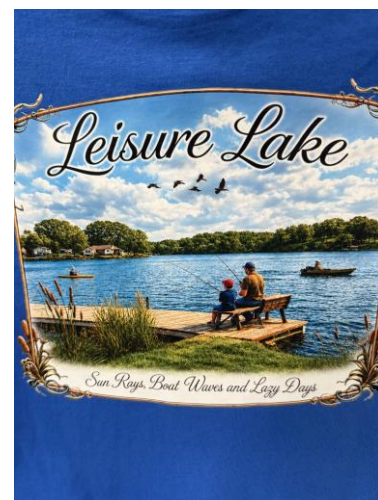
