Assessment Increase

The board voted on and approved an increase to the 2024 assessments. The first lot is \$200 and all other lots will be \$65 per lot, with a 5% increase for 5 years: 2025 - \$67 per lot, 2026 -\$71 per lot, 2027 - \$75 per lot, 2028 - \$79 per lot, 2029 - \$83 per lot. Special Assessments will remain the same at \$25 per lot. The increase is needed due to all of our bills increasing. The two largest expenses we have are for trash and rock.
