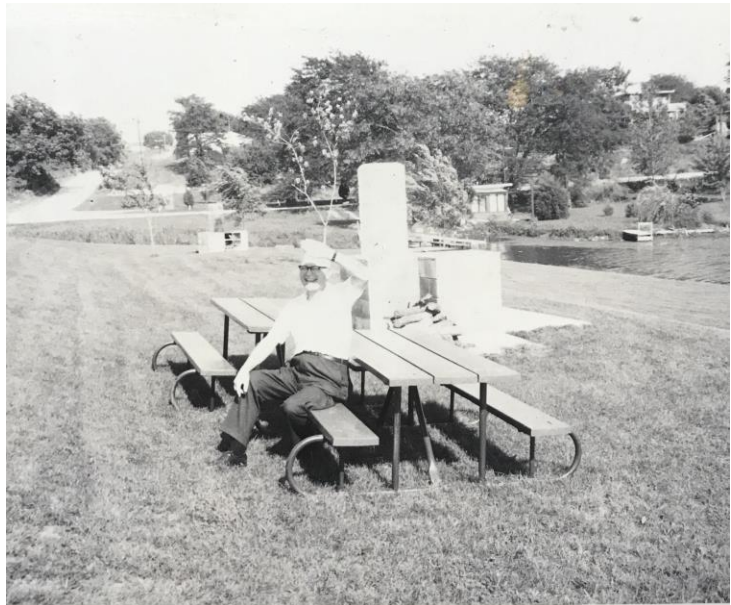
Deaths
