I want to thank those who attended the most recent board meeting at the shelter house. It has been a few months since the board has been able to meet during this continuing COVID-19 pandemic. It was good to see everyone and I appreciate those who set up the shelter house for the meeting so we could practice

social distancing recommendations as set forth by Missouri Governor Mike Parson. One of our biggest issues at the lake is roads and drainage and the limited funding the lake has to address those issues. We are currently over budget on road rock and will have to wait for the new budget in July to continue to put additional rock on roads. I want to remind everyone who uses the trash dumpsters: furniture, appliances, mattresses and other items are not allowed. Household trash that you would normally put in a household trash can is all that you are allowed to put into the dumpsters. We will be looking at the camera system to identify those who are violating the policies set forth in Leisure Lake bylaws and take appropriate action. I encourage everyone to stay safe under the current circumstances and work with us as we strive to make living at the lake and visiting a pleasant experience. Help us enhance the lake's natural beauty by cleaning up your properties or help your neighbor clean their property if they need assistance. Reminder quiet hours at the lake please refer to the by-laws with respect for those who live at the lake and have to work the following day by parking your four-wheelers and turning down your loud music.
