SEPTIC TANK INSTALL REQUIREMENTS FLYER

Only STATE CERTIFIED INSTALLERS are LEGALLY ALLOWED to INSTALL SEPTICS.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Call installer from list to acquire bid.
- 2. You hire installer installer applies for permit.
- 3. A CERTIFIED STATE INSPECTOR will come visit the site.
- 4. INSPECTOR digs a hole to check soil conditions (not a perc test) *in some cases hole can be 3'x3'
- 5. Once soil conditions determined INSPECTOR tells INSTALLER type of system to INSTALL. * Some systems are not suited for small lots. If your lot is too small for system needed NO PERMIT will be ISSUED.
- 6. After system INSTALLED INSPECTOR will revisit site.
- 7. INSPECTORS WILL NOT INSPECT A SYSTEM THAT NO PERMIT WAS ISSUED FOR.

WHAT TO DO FOR SEPTIC TANK ISSUES FOR NO SYSTEM or a FAILED SYSTEM

PER THE HEALTH DEPT. "AN AGGRIEVED PARTY" can FILE A REPORT. Their definition and examples of aggrieved was ANYONE Not just a Neighbor. that smells they are aggrieved, if it is going into a ditch, the neighborhood is Aggrieved. If your children are standing at the bus stop and they see or smell discharge your whole family is Aggrieved. If discharge is going into a ditch and that ditch drains into a creek or other water system the whole Lake Community is aggrieved. If that water system flows into a larger creek and into a state-controlled water system everyone owning land along the waterway is Aggrieved.

- 1. Present Proof of Dumping or a Failed system.
 - a. Collect a sample from area
 - b. Take a picture of area this is visual proof
- 2. Present proof to the HEALTH DEPARTMENT in TRENTON.
 - a. This will start an investigation.
