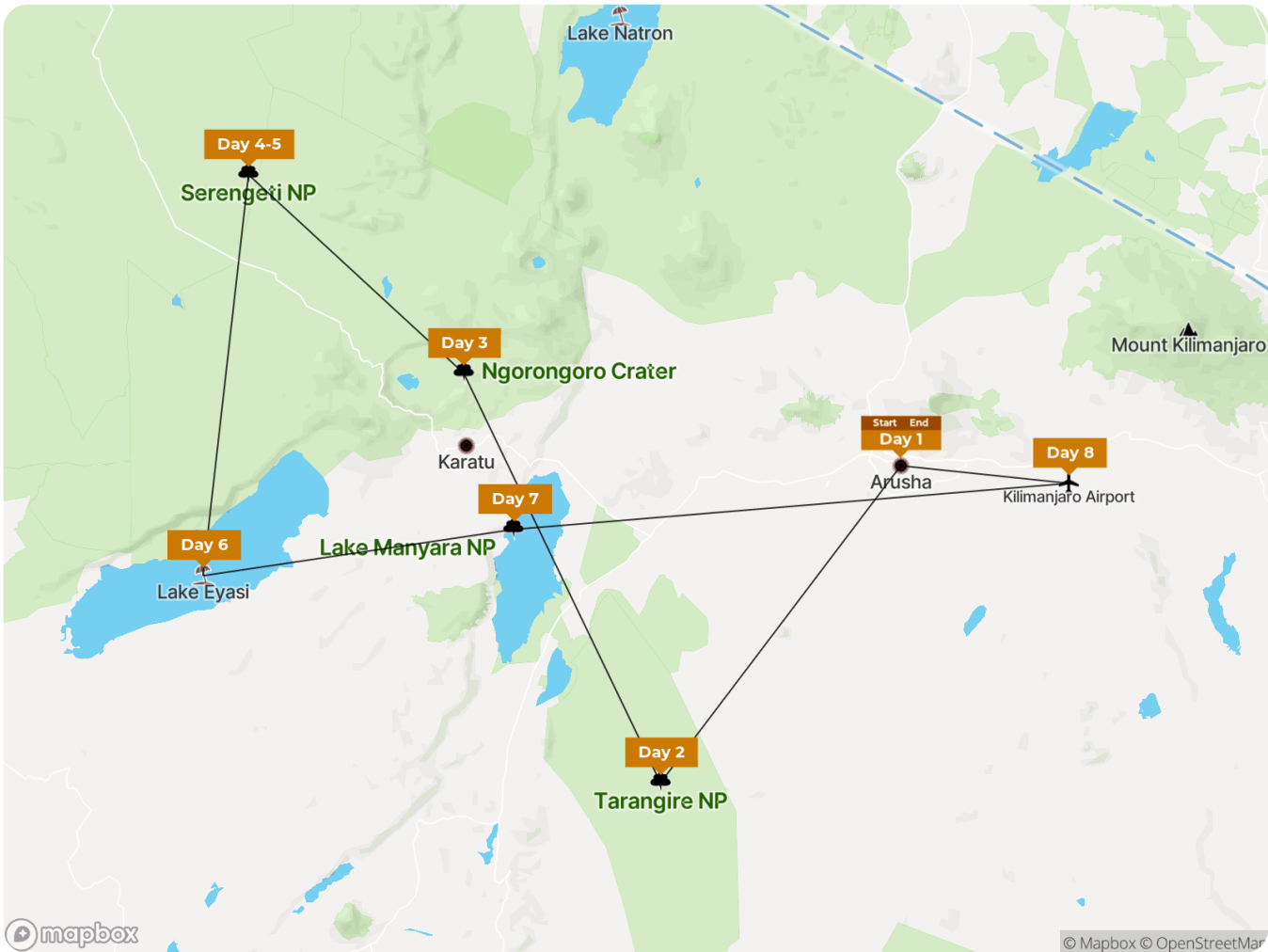

Arusha to Tarangire National Park

Wherever you go in Tarangire National Park, you'll come across the park's famous and larger-than-life baobab trees and elephants. These are the twin elements that give this park so much personality. There is, of course, so much more. We don't just mean the huge populations of wildebeest, giraffes, hippos, buffaloes, baboons, vervet monkeys and zebras. Or the rugged landscape of rocky hills and rivers, swamps and savannah plains. You also have an excellent chance of seeing lions here – Tarangire is a real lion stronghold – and keep an eye out for leopards and cheetahs as well.

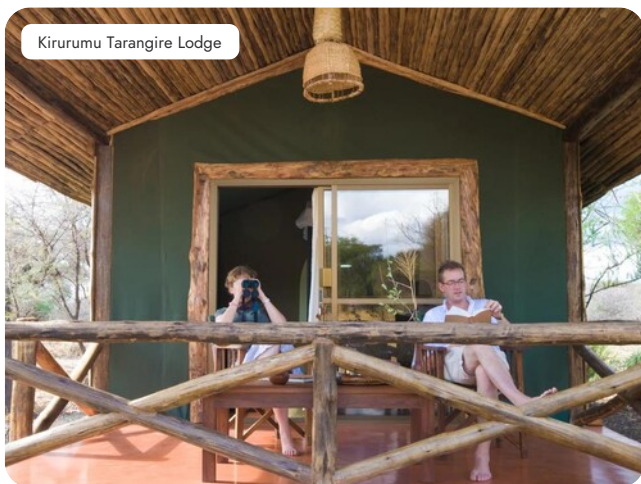

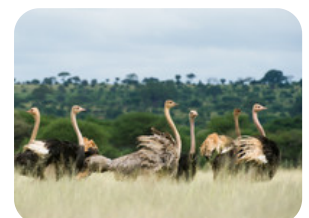
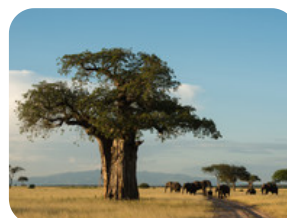

Tarangire National Park

Ngorongoro Crater to Serengeti

You'll learn why magical Ngorongoro is unlike anywhere else in Africa. Cloud forests encircle the crater rim, and the view out across the caldera of this former volcano – quite apart from the altitude – will leave you gasping for air. Your drive down a steep trail carries you onto the crater floor where a unique wildlife offering is added to the sheer beauty of the experience. You'll share the sunken ecosystem of the crater floor with hyenas, lions, elephants, black rhinos and hippos. An ecosystem that has formed in the crater in the millennia since the volcano wrought its terrible fury upon the land. It could just be one of your best safari days ever.

Serengeti National Park

Here in the Serengeti you'll find big cats (leopard, lion and cheetah), big herds (wildebeest, zebra and buffalo) and very big elephants.

Leaving the Serengeti National Park

Ngorongoro is a special conservation area and not a National Park. The whole area is managed for both animals and local Maasai people who graze their cattle alongside the indigenous wildlife. Arrive at the lodge in Karatu town for a retreat and prepare for a cultural visit tomorrow.



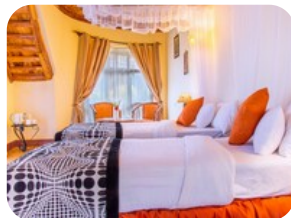

Cultural Visit to Hadzabe & Datoga

Lake Eyasi, located between the Eyasi escarpment and the Kidero Mountains, is a remote area where water levels fluctuate with the seasons. It is home to the Hadzabe, one of the last remaining hunter-gatherer tribes in Africa. Their language, similar to that of Southern Africa's Bushmen, features unique clicks and pops. The tribe consists of about one thousand people who live traditionally, relying entirely on hunting and gathering for sustenance, as they do not practice farming or raise livestock.

The Hadzabe are skilled hunters, using strong bows with strings made from giraffe tendons to hunt animals ranging from small birds to large game like zebras and buffaloes. Their arrows are often coated with poison from a tree they know well.

Additionally, the Hadzabe have ancient skills such as making fire by rubbing wood from the Commiphora tree, which also produces sap used as a mosquito repellent. Other trees, such as the Sansaveria, are used to create a snakebite cure, while Aloe vera is used for treating wounds.

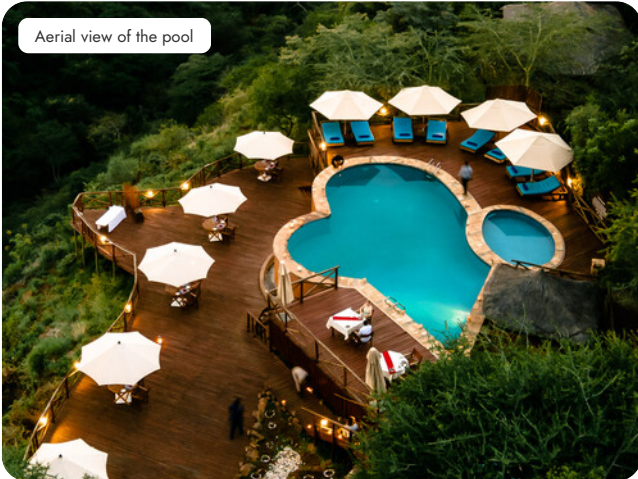

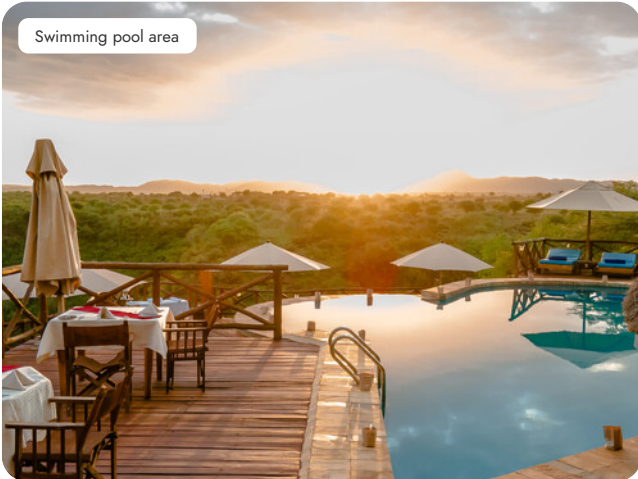

You're going to love Lake Manyara National Park because it promises experiences you just can't get elsewhere. For example, this is one of the most compact parks in Tanzania's north: the park consists of a narrow strip of forest shadowed by vast Lake Manyara on one side and the cliffs of the Rift Valley escarpment on the other. The park is known for its large elephant and baboon populations, and part of the excitement of visiting here is never quite knowing when you're going to come face-to-face with an elephant. And then there are the tree-climbing lions for which the park is famous: this is one of very few places in Africa where lions routinely climb (and spend much of their time up in) trees.

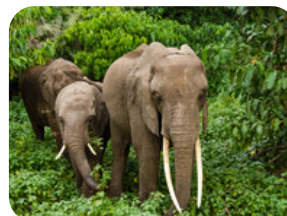
