FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS HABERSHAM COUNTY UNITED WAY?

Formed in 1978 by a group of local businessmen, Habersham County United Way is a local, nonprofit, 501C3 organization whose mission is to inspire our community to give, advocate and volunteer. We do this by identifying needs and mobilizing vetted resources to create positive local change within our 3 focus groups; Education, Financial Stability and Health.

WHY THE FOCUS ON EDUCATION, FINANCIAL STABILITY AND HEALTH?

Education, financial stability, and health are the building blocks of a good quality of life. By supporting partner agencies that work in these areas, HABUW is working towards creating the best possible life for everyone in Habersham County.

<u>EDUCATION</u> – HABUW believes that learning begins at birth and continues throughout life. Our aspiration is that all residents of Habersham County will have opportunities to learn ultimately helping them achieve their maximum potential. Education has many forms and is not limited to a classroom environment from kindergarten through high school. HABUW supports partner agencies who's programs support early learning, the well-being of school-aged children, and basic literacy and comprehension development skills.

<u>FINANCIAL STABILITY</u> – Habersham United Way believes that many families and individuals face obstacles to achieving financial stability and independence. Our aspiration is that all residents of Habersham County have opportunities to meet their basic needs and achieve self-sufficiency. Our partner agencies work to support local families as they actively pursue stability and independence by investing in resources that provide food, shelter, clothing, and also address barriers to selfsufficiency, and promoting financial stability.

<u>HEALTH</u> - Whether it is an individual or family without health insurance, a victim of abuse or someone struggling with mental illness or an addiction, HABUW believes in improving everyone's health and safety. Our aspiration is that all residents of Habersham are healthy and safe. We promote health and safety by investing in resources that will break the cycle of domestic violence, abuse, and neglect by improving access to primary medical, behavioral, dental care, as well as prevention and intervention in unsafe or unhealthy behaviors.

WHO DECIDES WHAT HABUW WILL BE INVOLVED IN?

HABUW is a volunteer-led organization in all of its functions; board of directors, structured communities, annual fundraising campaigns, and investment of resources in identified areas of priorities make up the foundation of HABUW and its involvement in the community. The responsibility entrusted to these individuals is great, and the decisions they make

are of significant importance to our community. It requires teamwork, communication, and a shared commitment to fulfilling HABUW's mission. A trained, professional staff has the support of the board and other volunteers in the day-to-day operations.

WHAT DOES "LIVE UNITED" MEAN?

"LIVE UNITED" is an invitation for all people to give, advocate, and volunteer as we work to create opportunities for a better life for all.

The challenges our community faces are greater than any one organization can address alone. It will take all of us contributing financial resources, lending our voice, and giving our time to create a good life for everyone. We all succeed when a child succeeds in school. We all are better when families are healthy and self-sufficient. We all win when we Live United.

WHY IS HABUW'S WORK IMPORTANT?

One single agency can not solve our community's problems alone, especially in these tough economic times. That is why HABUW is so important. By working together, United, we are providing individuals and families with support of food, utilities, shelter, counseling, child care, medical care and a long list of vital services that make a vast safety net for our community.

WHY SHOULD I GIVE TO HABUW?

We have one mission that drives everything we do and that is to improve lives in our community – to help create the best life possible for all. When people are educated, have self sufficient income to support themselves and their families, and are healthy, it strengthens the entire community. By funding agencies and their programs in these areas, we are making an investment that helps the community as a whole, not just the recipients of the services.

HABUW looks at more than simply the number of people receiving services. Investments are made in programs that demonstrate measurable success in achieving our goals in Education, Financial Stability, and Health.

I CAN'T AFFORD TO GIVE MUCH. WILL A SMALL AMOUNT DO ANY GOOD?

We know that giving is a personal decision that only you can make based on your income and other obligations. A gift of any amount is very much appreciated. We believe in the power of collective impact, a little can go a long way. Your gift added to those of thousands of other contributors, has the ability to make a great impact and change lives.

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS?

Having a set amount deducted from each paycheck enables most donors to contribute far more generously than they would be able to do if they gave their entire contribution all at once. Payroll deduction offers a convenient, effective way to stretch your charitable dollar and make a difference in our community.

DOEST MY GIFT STAY LOCAL?

Did you know that .83 cents of every dollar donated to HABUW is used to help fund our partner agencies. The other .17 cent pays for our office expenses, staff payroll and United Way Worldwide dues. These dues provide us with access to many membership services, Global Leadership Companies (ie. UPS, Johnson & Johnson Company), and the use of the United Way logo and branding.

WHAT IS HABUW'S RELATIONSHIP WITH UNITED WAY WORLDWIDE?

HABUW is an independent, locally governed organization charted in the state of Georgia. United Way Worldwide (UWW) is a trade association that was formed to assist member United Ways. It serves as a training and service center for United Ways across the country but is not a national headquarters and has no governance or financing authority over local United Ways.

HEALTH - Improving people's physical, mental and social well-being. We believe in improving everyone's health and safety. Our aspiration is that all residents of Habersham County are healthy and safe. Therefore, we will invest in:

- 1. Efforts to break the cycle of domestic violence, abuse and neglect
- 2. Improving access to primary medical, behavioral and dental health
- 3. Prevention of intervention in unsafe or unhealthy behaviors

2023 PARTNER AGENCIES & AWARDED GRANTS

We believe that we can do more together than we can alone. That is why we invest in these amazing partner agencies that help non-profits meet their goals that align with our Community Game Plan to create pathways out of poverty. Because of our generous donors, we are able to assist in funding 22 partner agencies and 2 grants in 2023.



MAKING THE ASK

the number one reason people say they do not give to HABUW is because no one ever asked them to. **Here are some tips for making the ask:**

- Educating employees about the value and work of HABUW is the best way to gain support. Your HABUW representative is an excellent source for material and assistance you may need. United Way speakers are always available to talk to your team about the impact of gifts made to Habersham County United Way.
- Personally distribute campaign pledge forms rather than including them in paychecks, mailboxes, emails. etc.
- Ask every employee to turn in a pledge form by a certain date, even if they choose not to contribute. This way, you'll know every person made a choice whether or not to participate without having to directly ask him/her. Many companies distribute pledge forms in envelopes that employees can fill out and seal, assuring their decision is private.
- Offer prizes and incentives for campaign participation. Prizes and incentives can increase the success of your campaign while showing employees that their participation is appreciated.
- Encourage your team to participate in virtual events or in-person. Whether it's volunteering, holding a fundraising event, or hosting a company-wide campaign kick-off, events are a great, fun way to get your team engaged in the work of United Way.
- Leverage United Way Giving Societies. When asking for donations, remember that HABUW Giving Societies provide a way for employees to extend their impact and deepen their engagement in HABUW's work.
 - 1. Tocqueville Society: \$10,000 + per year
 - 2. Leadership Giver Circle: \$500 + per year
- Don't forget to offer recognition and thanks. When the campaign is over, send thank you cards from your CEO, workplace campaign coordinator, or other influential team members. Highlight givers who increased their pledge by 10%, gave at a certain level, made their first gift, etc.

INCENTIVES

Prizes and incentives can provide a boost to the campaign while showing employees that their participation is appreciated. After a successful campaign, it's critical to thank all employees who made your campaign successful. People need to feel appreciated. Just as the best way to ask is the personal ask, the best way to thank your colleagues is to personally thank them. A thank you event publicly acknowledges your colleagues' generosity.

There are memorable ways of recognizing HABUW contributions. Have fun with it and get creative.
