So, read on...you will want to stay informed.




#### **Classes Resume**

# Your Donations Brought Great Joy to the People of the El Paso Homeless Shelters


Your generosity warms our hearts. Thank you!




Congratulations! We hope you enjoy every bit of your Pizza Party on the 24th. We also hope you share it with school administrators, but that's a whole 'nother story.
