GOLF RULES AT KOVE ESTATES This is a Private Golf course

1. Recreation facilities are for use of members and their families and guests. Golf fees are waived for member's children, their spouses and grandchildren, plus brothers and sisters along with their spouses and children all of whom are **houseguests**.

The fore-mentioned above who reside in the immediate area are limited to playing golf, no more than once a week with no charge. For any additional golf, the golf fee must be paid. (\$10.00).

Children under 12 years of age are not permitted on the golf course unless it is with special permission obtained for underage child by applying to the Board. The member must sign a release form to relieve the Association of any liability. Children 12-16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

- 2. Ignorance of the Rules and Regulations of the Park including the Golf Rules is not an excuse for not following the Rules & Regulations set by the Association and approved by the Board.
- 3. Rule regarding golf play is posted for your safety and convenience at the No. 1 tee. Failure to abide by these Rules could be cause of restrictions.
- 4. There is a ten dollar (\$10) fee per day for guests of the Park members which are not mentioned above. Please register your guests. (A book is provided in Golfside recreation hall for this purpose). Guest must always wear or have in their possession, a guest ID (qualification tag) when away from the host and his/her home.
- 5. The golf course will be open the following hours on the stated dates:

 November 1 through March 31 8 AM to dusk

 April 1 through October 31 7 AM to Dusk
- 6. Course is closed every Monday until 2:00 pm.
- 7. All golf play will start on No. 1 tee. Each player will have his or her own bag and clubs.
- 8. On #1 and #8 fairways, the bushes next to the fence, at the woods, are not out of bounds. If your ball is between the bushes and the fence, you get a free drop at the point of entry and no closer to the hole.
- 9. Play is no more than four-member teams except as approved by the committee. If playing in a two-some or four-some, please utilize carts fully. Do not use two carts for 2 people or 4 carts for 4 people. Encourage "cart pooling" to protect our course.
- 10. Slow players should let the following players play through if hole ahead is empty.
- 11. Do not hit a ball from No. 7 and no. 9 tees when cars or people are on the road.
- 12. Do not hit the ball if it is out of bounds or anyone's yard. Pick it up and carry it to the point of entry, takes a penalty, drop the ball and play on.

KOVE ESTATES GOLF SCRAMBLE RULES

FOUR PERSON SCRAMBLE FORMAT

- 1. A scramble means that all team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
- 2. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their ball from that chosen spot.
- 3. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green.
- 4. Putts need to be placed within 3 inches of the marked spot (not closer to the hole). The ball must go in the hole to be counted for your team score.
- 5. You may lift, clean and place your ball within one club length on the selected shot; however; YOU CAN NOT MOVE YOUR BALL OUT OF OR AWAY FROM A HAZARD: bunkers, out of the rough, from behind trees or bushes, from the fairway or rough to the apron, or from the apron onto the green.
