Baseball Heritage Museum

This first museum, the Baseball Heritage Museum in Akron, Ohio, is a lesser known and yet, very interesting museum. Please note, this is not the famous Baseball Hall of Fame museum in Cooperstown NY. Although, primarily a baseball museum, the Baseball Heritage Museum also displays some amazing artwork.

Located at League Park, the original home of Cleveland baseball, in the center of the historic Hough neighborhood of Cleveland, the Baseball Heritage Museum is dedicated to preserving the artifacts and stories of baseball's past with a special focus on diversity in the sport.

At the Baseball Heritage Museum, the public is able to experience the stories, photographs, letters, programs, uniforms, art and other treasured memorabilia, which detail the important contributions of the Latin and Caribbean leagues, the Industrial and Barnstormer leagues and the Negro and Women's leagues that helped shape the history of the great American pastime.
