

2 - The Prayer of Repentance

Prayer #1

Prayer #2

"Holy Father, I come before You today with a heart that longs for the experience of Your presence. I acknowledge that I have often allowed the call of this world and the weight of my own sins to separate me from the awareness of Your Spirit.

Lord, I ask that You search my heart right now. Reveal any hidden areas of pride, doubt, or compromise that have become a barrier between us. I repent for the times I have prioritized my own will and the false thrills of this world over the joy of a deep relationship with You. I renounce any bitterness, fear, or unholy pressure I have allowed to take root in my soul. Remove them from me now.

Wash me clean with the blood of Jesus. I ask for Your forgiveness and I turn away from these distractions. Create in me a clean heart and renew a right spirit within me. Do not cast me away from Your presence but restore to me the joy of Your salvation.

Holy Spirit, I invite You to fill me again today. Let Your peace and light flood every area of my life as I walk in holiness and truth throughout my day.
