Looking Back.....

The May luncheon, held in the newly decorated side of the country club, was well attended and a very topical presentation was made by Kathy Patterson, Communications Manager for Woods Hole Oceanographic Institute.

She was an enthusiastic speaker with a fascinating subject matter. We learned that the tallest mountains on earth are in the ocean and that earthquakes happen under the ocean. The research scientists at WHOI believe that the health of the ocean is critical to the future of the Earth. Ms. Patterson revealed that "Jason", a Remote Operation Vehicle built by WHOI's Deep Submergence Lab, found the Titanic. She also shared that under water, there are tethered vehicles (which "Jason" is) and autonomous vehicles. It allows scientists to access 98% of the sea floor without leaving the ship. Our speaker said that WHOI predicts in a few years that it will be feasible to mine the sea for minerals and metals. She highly recommended a visit to the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institute to experience all that it has to offer—for young and old alike!

To conclude the luncheon, there was a 50/50 drawing and a raffling of the centerpieces, so beautifully created by Kitty Gold.


