## What is the State Seal of Biliteracy? (1 of 2)



The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) awards the State Seal of Biliteracy to *graduating* high school students who can demonstrate proficiency in English in addition to one or more world languages.

### Requirements

- Demonstrated proficiency in the English language
- Demonstrated at least Intermediate Mid linguistic proficiency level (or higher) in the world language using an [NJDOE-approved assessment](#) ([N.J.A.C. 6A:8-5.3\(f\)](#))



# NJDOE Testing Window



The testing window for the Seal of Biliteracy starts during a student's junior year on January 1 and extends through February 8 of their senior year.

STAMP™ tests are available in the following languages:



## 2022-23 YTD

Major changes since last report (01/20/23):

### Income:

~ No major changes

### Expenses:

~ Net \$600 decrease in expenses primarily driven by:

- (\$2,000) transfer from Grad Ball account to fund professional fees; to be paid before end of year
- (\$800) donation from school store proceeds to offset 8th grade pool party expenses
- \$2,100 increase related to Wish List projects including partial payment for Prom Speaker as well as payment of Mascot Costume

### Additional Notes:

~ \$3,800 balance in Student Appreciation to be spent on student BBQ's

~ Additional Wish List projects have been approved and will be partially or fully funded by the HSA.





