

Early Intervention

TLC also provides high-quality Early Intervention services to children 0-3 years of age with developmental delays. At this young age, we work even more closely with the family, often in the home, to train them in how to support their young one's development. This age range is considered most important, as research indicates that high-quality Early Intervention can change a child's developmental trajectory, improve outcomes for children and their families and often reduces the need for specialized instructional support during a child's school years. Opportunities for play with a caregiver or Early Intervention specialist can facilitate the development of the skills needed for problem-solving, self-control, socialization and communication. This may be the most fun of the departments, as most goals are met through facilitation of play activities and engagement with family members!
