Summer Camp Instructors play a vital role in creating a meaningful experience for participants. Instructors must lead with confidence, embody our community values, and serve as mentors and role models. We're looking for enthusiastic, responsible individuals who love working with kids, value inclusivity, and are eager to share their passion for climbing.

Responsibilities:

- Represent Valley Rock Gym with authenticity, professionalism, and a positive attitude.
- Arrive on time, ready to contribute to a high-quality, safe, and fun camp experience.
- Work collaboratively with your co-instructor to design and lead well-rounded daily programming (e.g., warm-ups, climbing skills, games, arts and crafts, reflection etc).
- Welcome participants and families each day with friendliness, enthusiasm, and care.
- Ensure proper camper check-in and check-out, including sign-out by authorized guardians.
- Support and mentor Counselors-in-Training (CITs) by involving them in the planning process, delegating tasks appropriately, and offering both positive and constructive feedback to aid their growth.
- Address any unsafe or inappropriate behavior promptly and professionally.
- Monitor climbing area safety and ensure campers are in appropriate spaces within the gym.
- Assist with birthday parties one weekend per month.

Environmental and Physical Demands

- Comfortable working in a loud, high energy environment on a regular basis
- Comfortable working at height, moving up and down a climbing wall safely

- Experience working with children.
- Enthusiasm for climbing and interest in sharing that passion.
- Willingness to learn, grow, and contribute to a team.
- Comfortable giving and receiving constructive feedback.
- Strong communication skills.
- Climbing knowledge and technical experience are a plus.
- Current CPR and First Aid certification (or willingness to obtain within 3 months of hire).
