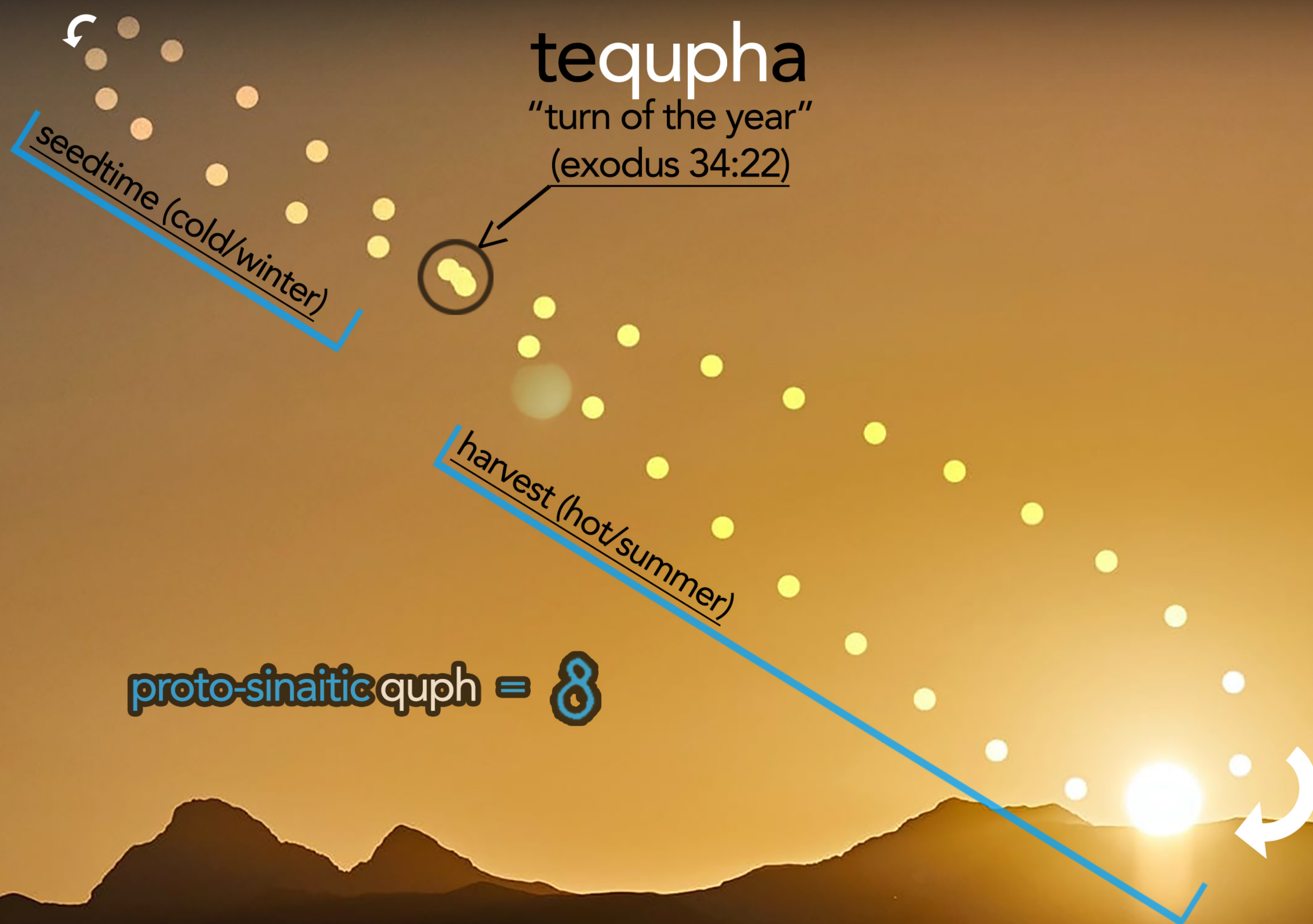

HOW DOES THE QODESH CALENDAR ACTUALLY WORK?

The hebrew year is structured around two agricultural seasons (Gen 8:22; Ex 34:21–22): **Seedtime** (cold) and **Harvest** (hot). These 2 seasons are divided by the tequpha—the “turning of the year”—which occurs twice annually. It marks the precise point when day and night are equal, with the sun rising and setting in perfect balance: equinox (12 hours of light, 12 hours of night). The **tequpha** and the **equinox** describe the same fixed astronomical event.



The harvest season begins with Abib, identified by the growth of barley after the tequpha. In the same way, the seventh month—marking the beginning of seedtime—must not begin before the tequpha. Keeping these boundaries maintains alignment with The Creator’s timing and removes the need for leap years or intercalary months. The calendar corrects itself through observation of this unchanging point—the tequpha. From there, the first new moon after each tequpha begins the count for that season (Gen 1:14, Psalm 104:19) AND marks the shabbat days continuing until the next tequpha.
