TRANSFORMATIONAL PROGRAM



The transformational program is a 12 month residency for men and women seeking to overcome homelessness, addiction and/or achieve a successful transition from prison.

We strive to instill independence, self-suffiency and purpose. Throughout this program our residents transform their lives. They are given the tools to overcome their obstacles to become better spouses, parents, friends, sons, daughters and neighbors. Upon conclusion of our program, the goal is for every individual to have faith, self-confidence, freedom from addiction, employment and education.

FOOD PROGRAM

Our sack lunch program is available daily for anyone in need of a meal. We provide more than 12,000 sack meals annually. Our food bank has distributed more than \$2 million worth of food to those in need since opening its doors in 2000. The food program continues to grow to meet the needs of the community. We feed 3,000 families in the Wiregrass each year with the help of volunteers and the generosity of donors.
