

Water Department Crew Member

Summary Description

Reporting to the Water Director, this position is responsible for assisting in the construction, repair, and maintenance of the water distribution system within the Unified Government of Cusseta-Chattahoochee County.

Job Responsibilities

- Taps water lines and installs water meters.
- Repairs leaking or broken water lines.
- Makes new service taps for customers.
- Locates and avoids damage to other underground utilities.
- Relocates existing water lines that are in conflict with proposed lines and other projects.
- Maintains inventory of supplies on service trucks and assists in maintaining an accurate inventory.
- Generates, maintains, and submits all required paperwork to the Water Department office.
- Maintains good public relations with water customers.
- Complies with all safety rules, regulations, and requirements of the Unified Government of Cusseta-Chattahoochee County.
- Responds to after-hours calls for water outages or repairs as required.
- Completes other duties as assigned by the Water Department Director.

Job Skills and Qualifications

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Work as part of a crew, or alone, whose primary responsibility is to water line laying, maintenance, and repair.
- Maintain regular, predictable and punctual attendance.
- Work a flexible schedule, which may include evenings, weekends, holidays and overtime.
- Ability to work under adverse weather conditions.
- Ability to operate and maintain a variety of digging and boring machinery and other related construction tools and equipment.
- Knowledge of safety regulations to work safely with equipment used in utility maintenance work.
- Ability to make decisions that prevent accidents and damage to property.
- Must have a working knowledge of hand tools, ability to work on water lines without contaminating the public water supply.
