1. The permittee must notify the UGOCCC Public Works Department at least 48 hours prior to the commencement of work and again 24 hours prior to work completion. Upon completion, the permittee shall contact the Public Works Department at (706) 989-3422 to schedule a final inspection.
2. Requirements for safety of utilities
 - a. The traveling public must be protected during installation by the use of proper warning signs or signals, both day and night. All warning devices shall be furnished, installed, and maintained by the permittee at their own expense, in compliance with the current edition of the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD)*. Traffic control shall be conducted in accordance with this manual.
 - b. All open trenches must comply with OSHA standards.
 - c. All work shall be performed during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

NOTICE

This permit becomes null and void if work or construction authorized by this permit is not begun within six (6) months from the date of issuance thereof, or if construction or work is suspended, or abandoned for a period of six (6) months at any time after work is commenced, unless an extension is approved by the Planning Commission for Cusseta-Chattahoochee County, Georgia.

I hereby certify, to the best of my knowledge and belief, that I have read and reviewed this document and that the information provided is true and correct. I further acknowledge that all applicable laws and ordinances governing this type of work will be observed, whether or not they are specifically referenced herein.
