## BUILDING PERMIT CHECKLIST

The following documents and information must be submitted to the permitting office in order to process your permit application:

- 1. Completed permit application
- 2. If you are not the property owner, you must have the property owner complete and sign a Property Owner Authorization Form
- 3. Stamped approval / Perc test (soil sample) results from the Health Department
- 4. Copy of Septic Plans
- 5. Copy of all Contractor's and Subcontractors State License
- 6. Copy of Contractor's and Subcontractors Business License
- 7. Copy of Contractor's and Subcontractors Liability insurance
- 8. Two (2) copies of construction plans
- 9. Elevation certification
- 10. Name, address, and phone number for the building inspector (or you may elect to use the county's designated inspector)
- 11. Permit fee must be paid (cash, check, card, or money order)

## **General Information:**

- Before a building permit can be issued, you must confirm the zoning requirements for your property. The Permitting Department is available to assist you in determining these requirements.
- Setback Information: Setback requirements vary by zoning district. This information can be obtained from the Permitting Department.
- Perc Test (Soil Sample): Contact the Health Department at 706-989-3663 to schedule a perc test. This test ensures that the soil is suitable for septic tank installation.
- If there is no water meter on site, a tap fee of \$1,000 is required for a ¾-inch line. Please allow two weeks for the Water Department to install the meter. Additional costs may apply if the tap must be bored under a street or highway. If a meter already exists on site, a \$100 deposit is required to the Water Department.
- To obtain electrical service, please contact Sumter Electric at 300A GA-520, Cusseta, GA 31805. Their telephone number is (706) 989-3323.

## **Important Notes:**

- All of the above items are required for every permit. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
- HVAC, electrical, and plumbing work must be performed by a state-licensed professional.
- Permits cannot be issued until the Health Department provides stamped approval.
- Once all required information is received, processing may take up to five (5) business days.
- No work may begin until the permit has been issued and posted on the property by the owner and/or contractor.
