

Heavy Equipment Operator

- Operate heavy equipment in compliance with the company's operating safety policies and procedures.
- Provide recommendations for maintaining and improving environmental performance.
- Load and unload equipment from vehicles and trailers.
- Ensure company equipment, material, and the work site are maintained, kept clean, and stored in a safe manner. Collect and dispose of scrap, excess materials, and refuse.
- Complete required paperwork, reporting, and other documentation
- Respond to all self-generated work orders as well as those called in for repairs and maintenance as it relates to asphalt, concrete, rock/gravel, and hazards.
- Provide the re-grading of ditches, removal of silt from ditches, silt ponds, retention ponds, and the laying of large pipes.
- Perform maintenance on designated unpaved roads for use by emergency vehicles, postal vehicles, and school buses.
- Responsible for the excavating and grading of all new and special projects within the county.
- Perform maintenance on the shoulders of all county and state roads. We provide equipment to load material for all departments of the county from the dirt stockpile.
- Support emergency management on fires, hazardous spills, storms, and demolishing buildings on county property.
- Support all inert and sanitary landfills with dirt and equipment on covering as needed and for fires in emergencies.
