Minutes of Monthly Meeting Monday, June 8, 2026 @ Town Hall – 8:30AM

Roll call: The full board was in attendance along with several residents.

The chairman called the meeting to order at 8:35AM

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

The agenda was approved on a motion made by Matt Orysen and seconded by Dean Klingbeil.

The minutes of the May monthly meeting were read. The minutes were approved on a motion made by Dean Klingbeil and seconded by Matt Orysen.

Items for tonight's meeting:

Road Bids: All road bids received were opened and considered. A motion was made by Dean Klingbeil, seconded by Matt Orysen and passed unanimously to go with the Fahrner contract in the amount of \$18,495 for the chip seal (oil) on Oak Knoll Rd. A motion was made by Matt Orysen, seconded by Dean Klingbeil and passed unanimously to go with the Superior contract in the amount of \$5,690 for the crack fill on Hiawatha, West Hillsdale, and Valley Road. A motion was made by Matt Orysen, seconded by Dean Klingbeil and passed unanimously to go with the Monarch contract in the amount of \$160,350 for the grind & pave of Birch Tree Ln (\$121,255.38) and the wedge & overlay on Oak Knoll Rd (\$39,094.62)

Rock Crushing: A motion was made by Matt Orysen, seconded by Dean Klingbeil and passed unanimously to go with the Haas bid of 5.50 per ton.

Mower: A motion was made by Dean Klingbeil, seconded by Matt Orysen and passed unanimously to go with the Tractor Central mower for \$20,000 (with trade-in).

The new contract with assessor Randy Prochnow was signed. The liquor license and 8 bartender licenses were approved on a motion made by Matt Orysen and seconded by Dean Klingbeil.

Road and Town Business: Lori confirmed food and arrangements for the picnic on June 28th. A motion was made by Matt Orysen and seconded by Dean Klingbeil to approve the purchase of a computer and a printer for the treasurer's office. Supervisor Dean Klingbeil will be moving out of the township at the end of July and he is willing to complete his term on the board which ends April of 2027.
