Town of Lincoln Sawmill Ordinance Ordinance Number 2022-23

An ordinance for Sawmill licensing in the Town of Lincoln, Eau Claire County, Wisconsin was adopted and therefore put into effect January 10, 2022.

Summary of Ordinance (to view the full ordinance, see instructions below)

Findings: The Town finds that all sawmills which may be constructed and operated in the Town require special licensing by the Town, in addition to any restrictions that may be imposed by Eau Claire County, to protect the public health and safety of Town residents and property owners.

Purposes and Intent: The purpose and intent of this Ordinance are to protect the public health and safety of the residents and property owners of the Town of Lincoln who may be affected by the development and operation of Sawmills. Such purposes and intent shall be accomplished by regulating noise, regulating dust, hours of operation, ensuring adequate fire protection, establishing adequate setbacks, protecting water quality, preventing soil erosion, regulating visual obstructions and preventing conflicts between incompatible land uses.

Licensing and fees: This ordinance establishes the Town of Lincoln's permit application process, requirements, and fees to be met by the applicant.
