3. School Update

Mrs McGoldrick, Head Teacher, Blackridge Primary School gave her apologies but submitted a brief update. Blackridge Primary School has successfully achieved **Reading Schools Accreditation**. This award celebrates the value placed on the school on reading for enjoyment and maximising opportunities for learners to do this. Our pupil 'Reader Leaders' worked very hard on gathering evidence for this award and we are delighted that we have had this national recognition.

The Nursery Team had the opportunity to share their practice at the recent **West Lothian Early Years Conference**. Following this, we have had lots of requests from staff from other settings to come and see our Nursery and the great things happening.

Christmas Fair has been arranged for Friday, 12th December 2025 between 11.00am – 2.00pm. Please note the first hour has been protected for ELC children and ASN to provide a quieter time.

Christmas Carol Concert will be held on Tuesday, 16th December 2025 from 2.15pm - 3.15pm in the school. A warm welcome is extended to all families and Community Council Members.

We will officially open our Sensory Room, funded through James Wood Bequest, on Thursday, 20th November 2025. Our senior pupils will lead on this. So far, the space has been used to support a few learners, and we are excited to see the impact it makes.
