### 3. School Update:

Blackridge Primary School.

Claire McGoldrick gave her apologies for being unable to attend but submitted an update. Gala Day arrangements are underway. Pupil Inclusion Ambassadors have been gathering ideas from across the school and this will be shared in the next week or so with the Community. The theme will be linked to literacy events within the school. Plans for classes to make arrangements with Craig Inn Centre over the coming term for visits. ELC & P1 have been visiting the Library. This is further supported through the Book Bug initiative being run. Transition arrangements to be shared with ELC & P7 parents in the coming weeks. ### Armadale Academy.

Revision of core values and work in the Community. Pupils have been involved in local groups and Churches finding out more about Community life. Invited to the next AGM at Craig Inn Centre and some senior pupils may attend and participate in discussions. Some Teachers and pupils are in Partnership with a school in Malawi and visiting there in the Summer.
