School Update:

Police Update:

Health Centre:

The Community Council was joined by members of the art class and by Dr Neil MacRitchie and new Practice Manager Anne Paton who wanted to provide update and receive feedback on the recent implementation of a new electronic system in the surgery. Dr MacRitchie highlighted that this system was not about limiting access but was instead about improving ability to gain appointments and to move away from 8am phonecalls for on the day appointments.

There was a wide ranging discussion and feedback was provided regarding the changes which most felt had been beneficial.

A specific concern regarding Monday holidays and access to pharmacies was asked. It was agreed Cllr McGuire would write to NHS Lothian and highlight this issue.
