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VISITATION DAY REQUIREMENTS For Pride Day Services

PRIDE offers visitation days prior to admission to ensure that our program is a good match for you. Visits can be scheduled with the Program Director, and advance notice is requested to ensure proper planning and preparation. Prior to a visitation day, we ask that the following documentation be provided to the day program:

- Current list of medications (including dose, frequency, administration time, route, purpose)
- Doctor's Orders for:
 1. medications to be administered during program hours
 2. seizure protocol (if seizure disorder present)
 3. supportive or assistive devices
 4. treatments to be performed during program hours along with any accompanying protocol
- Medications in pharmacy-labeled containers (matching doctor's order)
- Approved behavior plan (if applicable)
- Authorization forms to obtain/release information from pertinent sources (PCP/residential provider, etc.)
- Emergency Treatment Authorization form
- Emergency Fact Sheet, including contacts of staff/family in case of emergency

Please note, that if doctor's orders cannot be acquired, the visitation day must be adjusted to accommodate the medication administration.
