Dear Friends,

We are proud to announce that our 12th Annual Veterans Memorial Day Golf Tournament will be held on Thursday, May 22, 2025, at the Madera Country Club. We cordially invite you to participate in this tournament either as a sponsor, player, or donor.

This past year's tournament raised \$23,000 which benefited the Veterans in need of rehabilitation activities while at the Fresno Veterans Hospital and activities through other veterans' organizations we donate to. For us to continue this level of donation, we need your assistance. The Clovis Veterans Memorial District will be our naming rights sponsor, but we need many other levels of donation (See Attached Levels of Sponsorship and donations).

The tournament is under the guidance of the Clovis American Legion Cecil Cox Post 147 and partners with the Clovis Veterans of Foreign War Post 3225 and the Central Valley Blue Star Moms to organize the tournament. The Clovis American Legion Post 147 is a nonprofit corporation; tax I.D. # 94-6093632 and your donation may be deductible.

As our tournament has grown from 76 players in our first year to this past year of 128 players, our desire to work for our veterans has become a larger task; with your donation, the task becomes easier. By contract with the Fresno Veterans Hospital, none of the donations from the Veterans Memorial Day Golf Tournament shall be used by the hospital for administrative overhead expenses, and none of the funds may be used by the three organizations for their general operational expenses.

2025 VETERANS MEMORIAL DAY GOLF TOURNAMENT SPONSORSHIP LEVELS

\$10,000

PLATINUM LEVEL SPONSORSHIP

The Sponsor's name/logo will be used in all tournament literature. Platinum Sponsors will have two holes with tee sponsors signs and will have **two foursomes of golfers included in their pack**age. Platinum sponsors will also receive special recognition at the banquet and have up to **six additional individuals attend the banquet**. <u>Platinum sponsors may display advertising items at the banquet on either the tables or within a booth</u>.

GOLD LEVEL SPONSORSHIP \$5,000

The Sponsor's name/logo will be used in all tournament literature. Gold Sponsors will have **two holes with tee sponsors signs** and will have **two foursomes of golfers included in their package**. Gold sponsors will also receive special recognition at the banquet and have up to **six additional individuals attend the banquet**.

SILVER LEVEL SPONSOR \$4,000

The Sponsor's name/logo will be used in all tournament literature. Silver Sponsors will have one hole with a tee sponsors sign and will have **one foursome of golfers included in their package**. Silver sponsors will also receive special recognition at the banquet and have up to **four additional individuals attend the banquet**.

BRONZE LEVEL SPONSOR

The Sponsor's name/logo will be used in all tournament literature. Bronze Sponsors will have one hole with a tee sponsors sign and will have **one foursome of golfers included in their package**. Bronze sponsors will also receive special recognition at the banquet and have up to **two additional individuals attend the banquet**.

GOLF TOWEL SPONSORSHIP

The sponsor's name/logo will be stitched onto each golf towel. We estimate approximately 150 towels will be needed at a price of approximately \$10 per towel. The sponsor will be used on promotional materials and will receive a mention at the dinner. If the Sponsor just wants to supply the towels and **includes one foursome of golfers**.

GOLF BALL SPONSORSHIP

The sponsor's name/logo will be placed on the sleeve of golf balls included in each player's gift bag. We estimate approximately 36 sleeves will be needed at a price of approximately \$7 per sleeve. The sponsor name and logo will be used on promotional materials and will receive a mention at the dinner, 10 sleeves of logo golf balls, and **one foursome of golfers**.

DINNER SPONSOR

The sponsor's name/logo will be prominently displayed at the tournament Dinner. The dinner sponsor will receive a **foursome of golfers with the package**. The Dinner sponsor will also be included in the programs and advertising. The Dinner sponsor may pass out literature on the dinner tables.

LONG/MOST ACCURATE DRIVE SPONSORSHIP \$1,500

The sponsor's name/logo will be used on longest drive hole, and on the most accurate hole signs. The sponsor will be mentioned at the awards dinner and on all printed materials as soon as possible. The sponsorship will also **include one foursome** in the tournament.

19th HOLE SPONSORSHIP

The 19th hole sponsor will be the sponsor of the bar tickets. Each player receives two drink tickets valued at \$4.00 each. We anticipate 144 players and another 15 volunteers. The sponsorship includes name on all drink tickets, mention on day of the tournament program, and mentions at the dinner. The sponsorship will also include **two entries into the tournament**

PUTTING CONTEST

The Putting contest sponsor will have a "tee sign" at the putting green. There will be contests for men and women, and each contestant will receive a special prize (generally a putter). The sponsor will also receive special recognition.

LUNCH SPONSOR

The Lunch sponsor will have a "tee Sign" at the food area. The sponsor will be mentioned in all the printed literature and mentioned at the dinner and will receive special recognition.

CLOSEST TO THE PIN (Men's & Women's) \$750

There are two closest to the pin holes. The sponsor will be mentioned in the program as the closest to the pin and will be mentioned at the awards dinner. The sponsor will also have a "tee sign" with their name affixed.

TEE SPONSORS SIGN

Tee sponsors will receive a hole and tee sign with their name affixed. The tee sponsors will also receive the sign upon completion of the tournament. Tee sponsors will be mentioned in the program and if time permits at the awards dinner.

OTHER NON-CASH SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

We welcome other in-kind sponsorships. Those may include items to distribute to each player in Tee Bag, including but not limited to Promotion Items from the business, Discount cards, or raffle items from the business. If you are interested in a donation in the way of having a booth on the course, please contact us so we can discuss your needs. If you are interested interested in another in-kind sponsorship, please feel free to contact us and we will be most happy to discuss your ideas.

In general, we believe we have a premier golf tournament, one in which players and sponsors want to return.
