The final stages of construction on the JFM OI Daraja Church, located atop a hill, were completed in April. The dedication of the new church building was scheduled for April 19, 2026. An evangelistic outreach and children's ministry was held a few days before the dedication service. Twentyone adults and 12 children received the Gospel and became followers of Jesus, and the children's attendance increased from 13 on the first day to 69!



The Holy Spirit put a dedication message in Pastor Cheryl's heart from the book of Nehemiah. It focused on the teamwork required to accomplish a task and on the determination to not be discouraged by the enemy's attacks.

The book of Nehemiah tells us that the people worked with a tool in one hand and a sword in the other. For protection the Maasai carry a weapon called "rungu." We also need to work faithfully as we fight the forces of evil with the "Sword of the Spirit!"

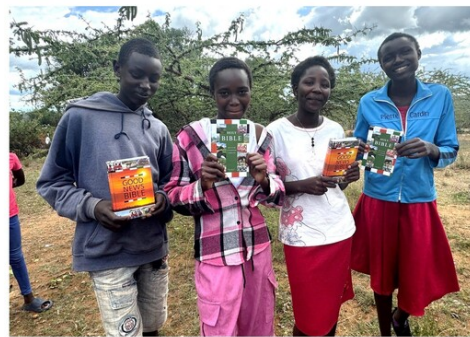


The message ended with Chapters 8 and 9 of Nehemiah, where the people listened for hours to the Word of God, and

Please pray for Mike and Cheryl as they travel back to America in early May.



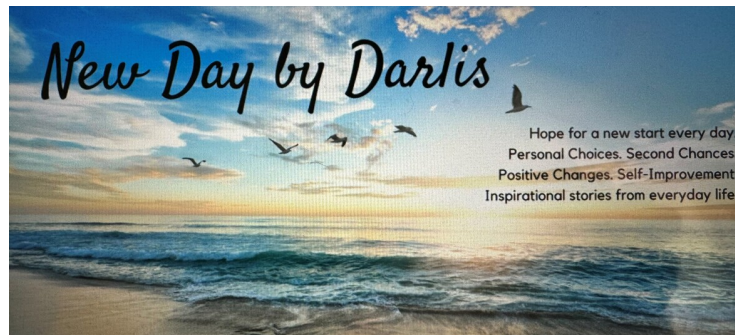
