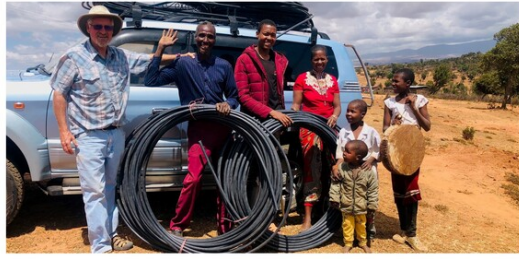
The JFM Luanda Church Youth Group and Sunday School continue to grow in numbers and in the Word of God.
