Recently, I was reading a book entitled "The Speed of Trust" by Stephen Covey. The writer shared current statistics regarding trust issues in the United States today:

- Only 25% of Americans trust the government
- Only 22% trust the media
- Only 33% trust other people

It makes one wonder, if Christians were asked whether they FULLY trust God with every aspect of life and resources-what would the response be? Our ability to trust affects every relationship we have, our ability to trust God affects everything in our lives, our ability to trust God affects HOW WE PRAY!

Is our Lord trustworthy? If your answer is "yes," then you MUST believe that our God is completely and wholly sovereign-supreme in power and authority, excellent and effectual in all matters, and has complete dominion and control over all things! (definition of sovereignty)
