## LOOK WHAT THE LORD HAS DONE!

JFM REPORTING PERIOD (beginning 4-1-2020 through 3-31-2021)

In his daily devotional for December 31st, Oswald Chambers quotes Isaiah 52:12. "You shall not go out with haste, ... for the LORD will go before you, and the God of Israel will be your rear guard." "At the end of the year, we turn with eagerness to all that God has for the future. As we go forth into the coming year, let it not be in the haste of impetuous, forgetful delight, nor with the quickness of impulsive thoughtlessness. But let us go out with the patient power of knowing that the God of Israel will go before us!" This is our prayer for 2022, "LORD, we thank you for everything that was accomplished in 2021, please go before us that your will may be done, for the glory and honor of Your Name!

Here's a brief look at our fiscal year for 2021 which occurred during the peak of the Covid-19 pandemic. JFM was able to assist Kenyans who were traumatized by lock downs, unemployment, and illness. Food relief was distributed at several JFM Churches. Assistance and Bibles were even given to suffering prison inmates. Our JFM Entapipi Education Center continued to grow strong! All Kenyan schools were closed for 10 months due to the pandemic and most teachers weren't paid. Praise God, JFM continued to fully fund our teachers and staff. When school resumed in January 2021, upon reopening, enrollment soared to 42 children! Construction continued at the school campus. The foundation was laid for additional school staff quarters. A new water line was installed along with a new 3000-liter water tank and the boys/men's restroom was completed.

The 20-acre parcel which will be the future home of the JFM Kenya Headquarters, Mission Center, orphanage and green house contains the water well that was drilled in 2019 and the completed pump-house. In this reporting period a steel tower was constructed for 14-solar panels and a 10,000-liter water tank was purchased and installed. 150 meters of water line was laid from the pump to the storage tank. The well produces 1,300 gallons of water per hour. This good water has made a tremendous difference in the lives of the Maasai community living in the Chumvi area.

They and the school now have a reliable source of excellent drinking water. JFM continues to connect American sponsors with less fortunate and fatherless children. Through their donations to JFM school fees, uniforms, books, shoes, and food are provided for these children. During this reporting period our sponsorships increased to 38 students who are receiving help! We happily report that four JFM sponsored students successfully graduated from high school!

Three new JFM Churches were established this year, two in Northern and one in Western Kenya. 28-JFM Pastors met for a 4-day training conference in Chumvi, Kenya. The leadership of JFM ordained 3-JFM pastors. Two JFM pastors attended the School of Christ Bible school in Nairobi. Help was given to various JFM churches. Assistance with yearly rent was given to 2-JFM churches. Contributions for a new piano keyboard, two churches were helped with speakers and microphones. The JFM Gitathi-ini church was given funds to finish their Sunday school room, pastor's office, pit-latrine restrooms and to provide piped water to the church. The JFM Luanda Church was assisted with funds to construct a 3-room church pre-school/kindergarten and to install a cement floor inside the main church building. They also purchased a power meter and ran electricity to the church. Three pastors received mobile phones to aid in their communication with members.

During this 2021 reporting period, a 6-month Bible study course called "Live in the Word" was developed for the JFM churches by our JFM Board Secretary, Sherry Cox. The books were translated, printed, and distributed to each member. 255 Bibles and 22 audio Bibles were placed in the hands of Kenyans hungry for the Word of God. By His grace, in this year of restricted movement, the love of God continued to touch hearts and 85 Kenyans gave their lives to Christ!

Thank you so much for your contributions in 2021. You have helped us serve the people of Kenya for another year. May God bless you so much for your sacrifice to His work!
