
loves Jesus.

Focusing in on Fatuma

Fatuma's father left when she was a very young child. Her mother became a Christian when Fatuma was 4 years old. On the day Fatuma's mom was baptized and her little sister, Vicky, was dedicated to the Lord, 9-year-old Fatuma gave her life to Jesus!



Paying school fees in Kenya is a real struggle, especially for single moms or relatives caring for orphaned children. When Cheryl's daughter, Adelle, heard about Fatuma's school fee challenge, Adelle and her family, aka "Team Danson," "stepped up to the plate" and started sending in monthly assistance for Fatuma. Team Danson receives letters and photos from Fatuma, and they send her gifts on special occasions.



Fatuma was baptized in 2020; she has been one of the top students at her school since pre-primary; Fatuma's score on her 8th-grade closing exam earned her admission at a prominent boarding high school. Fatuma is a leader in the Christian Club at her school. She was recently awarded a trophy for the category of the most-disciplined student; she also received a bronze medal at the science fair. This year

she was chosen along with 30 other girls from her high school to compete against girls from other high schools for the prize of meeting Kenyan President Ruto at the State House. After 3 rounds of competition, Fatuma is one of the 5 remaining girls from her school still in the running for the award.


