Upon our arrival we discovered that the Hospital was founded and run by Americans. One of the doctors asked us where we were from and we said, "Bend, Oregon." That's when we found out that Dr. Mike Mara, an orthopedic surgeon from Bend, Oregon, had been volunteering at the Kijabe Hospital for 2 years!!! The next day we met Dr Mara and he remembered treating my husband, Mike in the U.S. in 2007!!! Coincidence? No way!!!

"I HAVE BROUGHT YOU GLORY..." John 17:4 A Missions Message From The JFM Board Secretary




> "I have brought you glory on earth by completing the work you gave me to do." John 17:4

Special JFM Prayer Request

The medical camp that was held in the Nyeri Prison in January saw 115 souls come to the Savior. JFM was expecting a \$500 contribution to help cover some of the costs. Unfortunately, it never came. In addition, we had a pipe break at the JFM Mission House and the water was lost underground. The bill for that one month was \$1238. Mike negotiated with the water company and thankfully they are willing to reduce the bill by half. In April JFM will need to pay 2nd term school fees of \$1200 for the 19 Students JFM sponsors. The Heavenly Father knows what have need of before we even ask but we are also told to ask!
