January 7th 2019 the school doors opened and 9 little children entered the Entapipi JFM Education Center. The number of students has steadily grown to 19. Entapipi means clover in the Maasai language and it is found in this area of Chumvi.

Because Kenya was a British Colony, schools and government offices are conducted in English. The official Kenyan conversational language is Swahili. These little children speak the Maasai language which is their "mother tongue" but they will spend the next three years learning to speak English and Swahili. They will learn to read and write and do math problems.



Many of these precious children have never held a storybook, played with a real ball or played on playground equipment. They do now! They receive breakfast, lunch, a school uniform and an excellent education all for a charge of \$3.50 per month. Teacher Naomi says they don't want to leave school at the end of the day! Two years ago JFM received a check from the Children's and Youth Departments of Calvary Chapel Bartlesville Oklahoma. These children and their teacher, Jenny Lowery, had a vision for a well in Chumvi. Praise the Lord!!! Although it took a couple of years to raise funds and there were some struggles and delays during the drilling process, at the beginning of March WATER WAS FOUND IN CHUMVI!!!

The well drilling stopped at 558 feet and the output is 1,300 gallons an hour. For now the well is capped as funds are raised for the pump, pump house, power source and storage tanks. The same God who brought water from the rock is still making provision today!
