


March 2024 - Saying "Goodbye"

Nominated by the Cottage Grove Jaycee-ettes, Mrs. Freese will be included in the annual biographical compilation, Outstanding Young Women of America, the publication sponsoring the honor. Mom lived a full life in her 87 years.

She was a faithful member of the Bethany Free Lutheran Church in Astoria, Oregon. In 1969, she was honored to be selected as an "Outstanding Young Woman of America." Mom was an excellent artist and florist. She loved camping, and on her 75th birthday, she climbed Saddleback Mountain in Clatsop County, Oregon. On her 80th birthday, she tried zip-lining. She passed in Sweet Home Oregon, at the home of my sister, Debbie Tertrou, who was caring for Mom. My sisters Barbara and Debbie, the extended family, and I will miss Mom and remember the good times we've shared.


Please join us in praying for these Kenyan needs:
